REAL ESTATE CONTRACT

THIS CONTRACT, made and entered into this 25th day of April 1975.

WITNESSETH: That the seller agrees to sell to the purchaser and the purchaser agrees to purchase from the seller the following described real estate, with the appurtenances, in Skamania County, State of Washington:

The terms and conditions of this contract are as follows: The purchase price is FIFTEEN THOUSAND and NO/100
-(\$ 15,000.00) Dollars, of which

-(\$2,000.00) Dollars have been paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, and the balance of said purchase price shall be paid as follows:

The purchasers agree to pay the balance of the purchase price in the sum of Thirteen Thousand and No/100 (\$13,000.00) Dollars in monthly installments of One Hundred Eight and 74/100 (\$108.74) Dollars, or more, commencing on the first day of June, 1975, and for 35 consecutive months thereafter to and including the first day of May, 1978; and thereafter in monthly installments of One Hundred Eighty-eight and 66/100 (\$188.66) Dollars, or more, commencing on the first day of June, 1978, and on the first day of each and every month thereafter until the full amount of the purchase price together with interest shall have been paid. The said monthly installments shall include interest at the rate of eight percent (8%) per annum computed upon the monthly balances of the unpaid purchase price, and shall be applied first to interest and then to principal. The purchasery reserve the right at any time they are not in default under the terms and conditions of this contract to pay without penalty any part or all of the unpaid purchase price, plus interest, then due.

All payments to be made hereunder shall be made at P. O. Box 454, Carson, Washington 98610 or at such other place as the seller may lirect in writing.

As referred to in this contract, "date of closing" shall be May 1, 1975.

- (1) The purchaser assumes and agrees to pay before delinquency all taxes and assessments that may as between granter and grantee hereafter become a lien on said real estate; and if by the terms of this contract the purchaser has assumed payment of any mortgage, contract or other encumbrance, or has assumed payment of or agreed to purchase subject to, any taxes or assessments now a lien on said real estate, the purchaser agrees to pay the same before delinquency.
- (2) The purchaser agrees, until the purchase price is fully paid, to keep the buildings now and hereafter placed on cald real estate insured to the actual cash value thereof against loss or damage by both five and windstorm in a company acceptable to the seller and for the seller's benefit, as his interest may appear, and to pay all premiums therefor and to deliver all policies and renewals thereof to the seller.
- (3) The purchaser agrees that full inspection of said real estate has been made and that neither the seller nor his assigns shall be held to any covenant respecting the condition of any improvements thereon nor shall the purchaser or seller or the assigns of either be held to any covenant or agreement for alterations, improvements or repairs unless the covenance; or agreement relied on is contained herein or is in writing and attached to and made a part of this contract.

 (4) The purchaser assumes all hazards of damage to or destruction of any improvements now on said real estate or hereafter placed thereon, and of the taking of said real estate or any part thereof for public use; and agrees that no such damage, destruction or taking shall constitute a failure of consideration. In case any part of said real estate is taken for public use, the portion of the condemnation award remaining after payment of reasonable expenses of procuring the same shall be paid to the seller and applied as payment on the purchase price herein unless the seller elects to allow the purchaser to apply all or a portion of such condemnation award to the rebuilding or restoration of any improvements damaged by such taking.  - b. Liens or encumbrances which by the terms of this contract the purchaser is to assume, or as to which the conveyance hereunder is to be made subject; and
 - c. Any existing contract or contracts under which seller is purchasing said real estate, and any mortgage or other obligation, which seller by this contract agrees to pay, none of which for the purpose of this paragraph (5) shall be deemed defects in seller's title.

(6) If seller's title to said real estate is subject to an existing contract or contracts under which seller is purchasing said real estate, any mortgage or other obligation, which seller is to pay, seller agrees to make such payments in accordance with the terms thereof, and be applied to the payments next falling due the seller under this contract.

(7) The seller agrees, upon receiving full payment of the purchase price and interest in the manner above specified, to execute and deliver to purchaser a statutory warranty

(10) Time is of the essence of this contract, and it is agreed that in case the purchaser shall fail to comply with or perform any condition or agreement hereof or to make any payment required hereunder promptly at the time and in the manner herein required, the seller may elect to declare all the purchaser's rights hereunder terminated, and upon his doing so, all payments made by the purchaser have right to re-enter and take possession of the real estate shall be forfeited to the seller as liquidated damages, and the seller shall be contrued as a walver of any subsequent default.

Service upon purchaser of all demands, notices or other papers with respect to forfeiture and termination of purchaser's rights may be made by United States Mail, postage pre-paid, return receipt requested, directed to the purchaser at his address last known to the seller.

(11) Upon seller's election to bring suit to enforce any covenant of this contract, including suit to collect any payment required sums shall be included in any judgment or decree entered in such suit.
