## REAL ESTATE CONTRACT

(6) If celler's title to said real estate is subject to an existing contract or contracts under which seller is purchasing said real estate, or any mortgage or other obligation, which seller is to pay, seller agrees to make such payments in accordance with the terms thereof, and upon default, the purchaser shall have the right to make any payments necessary to remove the default, and any payments so made shall be applied to the payments next falling due the seller under this contract.

The seller agrees, upon receiving full payment of the purchase price and interest in the manner above specified, to execute and deed to said real estate, excepting any part thereof hereafter deliver to purchaser a statutery warranty taken for public use, free of excumbrances except any that may attach after date of closing through any person other than the seller, and subject to the following:

(8) Unless a different date is provided for herein, the purchaser shall be entitled to possession of said real estate on date of closing, and to retain possession so long as purchaser is not in default hereunder. The purchaser covenants to keep the buildings and other improvements on said real estate in good repair and not to permit waste and not to use, or permit the use of, the real estate for any literal purpose. The purchaser covenants to pay all service, installation or construction charges for water, sewer, electristry, garbage or other utility services (unrished to said real estate after the date purchaser is entitled to possession.

(9) In case the purchaser fails to make any payment herein provided or to maintain insurance, as herein security the celler may make such payment or effect such insurance, and any amounts so pold by the seller, together with interest at the rate of 10% per annum thereon from date of payment until repaid, shall be repayable by purchaser on seller's demand, all without prejudice to take other right the seller might have by reason of such default.

(10) Time is of the essence of this contract, and it is agreed that in case the purchaser shall fall to comply with or perform any condition or ogreement hereof or to make any payment required hereunder promptly at the time and in the manner herein required, the seller may elect to declare all the purchaser's rights hereunder terminated, and upon his doing so, all payments unde by the purchaser hereunder and all improvements placed upon the real estate shall be forfeited to the seller as liquidated damages, and the seller shall have right to re-enter and take possession of the real estate; and no waiver by the seller of any default on the part of the purchaser shall be extracted as a waiver of any subsequent default.

5-ryice upon purchaser of all demands, potices or other papers with respect to forfeiture and termination of purchaser's rights may be made by United States Mail, postage pre-paid, return receipt requested, directed to the purchaser at his address last known to the seller.

(11) Upon seller's election to bring suit to enforce any covenant of this contract, including suit to collect any payment required hereunder, the purchaser agrees to pay a reasonable sum as attorney's fees and all costs and expenses in connection with such suit, which sums shall be included in any judgment or decree entered in such suit.

If the seller shall hing suit to procure an adjudication of the termination of the purchaser's rights becauser, and independ to an expense of the purchaser's rights becaused.

If the seller shall bring sult to procure an adjudication of the termination of the purchaser's rights bereunder, and judgment is so entered, the purchaser agrees to pay a reasonable cum as attorney's fees and all costs and expenses in connection with such suit, and also the reasonable cost of scarching records to determine the condition of title at the date such suit is commenced, which sums shall be included in any judgment or decree entered in such suit.
