(1) The purchaser assumes and agrees to pay before delinquency all taxes and assessments that may as between granter and granter hereafter become a lien on suid real estate, and if by the terms of this contract the purchaser has assumed payment of any motifage, contract or other encumbrance, or has assumed payment of or agreed to purchase subject to, any taxes or assessments now a lien on said real estate, the purchaser agrees to pay the same before delinquency.

Any existing contract or contracts under which seller is purchasing said real existe, and any mortrage of which obliga-tion, which seller by this contract agrees to pay, none of which for the purpose of this paragraph (5) shall is deemed defects in seller's title.

(6) If seller's title to sold real estate is subject to an axisting contract or contracts under which seller is purcheding sold real estate, or any mortgage or other obligation which seller is to pay, seller agrees to make such payments in accordance with the terms thereof, and upon default, the parchaser shall have the right to make any payments necessary to recover the default, and any payments so made shall be applied to the payments next falling due the seller under this contract.

(7) The neller agrees, upon receiving full payment of the purchase price and interast is the manner above specified, to execute and deliver to purchaser a statistory warrakity... \_deed to said real estate, excepting any part thereof hereafter taken for public use, free ob encumbrances except any that may attach after date of closing through any parson other than the soller, and subject to the following:

(8) Unless a different flate is provided for herein, the purchaser shall be entitled to possession of sold real estate an date of closing and to retain Hossession so long as purchaser is not in default hereunder. The purchaser covenants to keep the Exildings and other improvements on said real estate in good repair and not to permit waste and not to use, or permit the use of, the real estate for any illegal purpose. The purchaser covenants to pay all service, installation or construction charges for watter, sewer, electricity, garbage or other utility services furnished to said real estate after the date purchaser is entitled to possession.

(9) In case the purchaser falls to make any payment herein provided or to maintain insurance, as herein required, the saller may make such payment or affect such insurance, and any amounts so poid by the seller, together with interest at the rate of 10% per annum thereon from date of payment until repaid, shall be repayable by purchaser on seller's demand, all without prejudice to any other right the seller might have by reason of such default.

(10) Time is of the essence of this contract, and it is agreed that in case the purchaser shall fail to comply with or perform any condition or agreement hereof or to make any payment required, the seller any elect to declare all the purchasir's rights hereunder terminated, and upon his doing so, all payments made by the purchaser hereunder and all improvements placed upon the real estate shall be forfested to the seller as liquidated damages, and the seller shall have right to re-enter and take possession of the real estate; such any waiter by the seller of any default on the part of the purchaser shall be construed as a waiver of any subsequent default.

Service upon purchaser of all demands, notices or other papers with respect to forfetture and termination of purchaser's right may be made by United States Mail, postage pre-paid, return receipt requested, directed to the purchaser at his address least hown to the seller.

(11) Upon seller's election to bring suit to enforce any covenant of this contract, including suit to collect any payment required hereunder, the purchaser agrees to pay a reasonable sum as attermey's fees and all costs and expenses in connection with such suit, which sums shall be included in any judgment or decrse entered in such suit.

If the seller shall bring suit to procure an adjudaction of the \*remination of the purchaser's rights hereunder, and judgment is so entered, the purchaser agrees to pay a reasonable sum as alterney's fees and all costs and expenses in connection with such suit, and also the reasonable cost of searching records a determine the condition of title at the date such suit is commenced, which sums shall be included in any judgment or decree entered in such suit.
