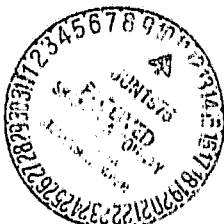

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SCHEDULE "A"

AUTHORITY FOR THE TAKING:

The authority for the taking of the land is under and in accordance with the Act of Congress approved February 26, 1931 (46 Stat. 1421, 40 U.S.C. 258a), and acts supplementary thereto and amendatory thereof, and under the further authority of the Acts of Congress approved April 14, 1888 (25 Stat. 94, 33 U.S.C. 591), and March 1, 1917 (39 Stat. 948, 33 U.S.C. 701), which authorize the acquisition of land for flood control projects; the Act of Congress approved August 30, 1935 (49 Stat. 1028), which act authorizes the construction of the Bonneville Dam (Oregon and Washington); the Act of Congress, approved August 20, 1937 (50 Stat. 731), which act authorized completion, maintenance and operation of the project and the Act of Congress approved August 28, 1974 (Public Law 93-393), which act appropriated funds for such purpose.

PUBLIC USES:

The public uses for which said land is taken are as follows: The said land is necessary to provide for the construction of a river improvement for the purposes of flood control, navigation and for other uses incident thereto. The said land has been selected for acquisition by the United States for use in connection with the construction and maintenance of the Second Powerhouse which must be provided at the Bonneville Dam, and for such other uses as may be authorized by Congress or by Executive Order.

SCHEDULE "B"

TRACT NO. 2505

DESCRIPTION:

A tract of land situated in Section 21, Township 2 North, Range 7 East of the Willamette Meridian, Skamania County, Washington, being more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the Northeast corner of said Section 21; thence South 1257.00 feet; thence West 38.93 feet to the Southerly right-of-way of the Evergreen Highway (State Highway No. 14); thence North 81°00'00" West along said right-of-way 400.00 feet; thence South 09°00'00" West 50.00 feet to the point of beginning; thence continuing South 09°00'00" West 50.00 feet; thence South 81°00'00" East 47.50 feet; thence North 09°00'00" East 50.00 feet; thence North 81°00'00" West 47.50 feet to the point of beginning, said tract being designated as the Westerly 47.50 feet of Lot 8 of Block 3 of the unrecorded plat of the Town of North Bonneville, Washington.

Also including one-half of the adjacent streets and alleys.
