- (b) The public uses for which said land is taken are as follows: The said land is necessary to provide for the construction of a river improvement for the purposes of flood control, navigation and for other uses incident thereto. The said land has been selected by me for acquisition by the United States for use in connection with the construction and maintenance of the Second Powerhouse which must be provided the Bonneville Dam, and for such other uses as may be authorized by Congress or by Executive Order.
- 2. A general description of the land being taken is set forth in Schedule "A", attached hereto and made a part hereof, and is a description of the same land described in the complaint in the above entitled cause.
- 3. The estate taken for said public uses is the fee simple title, subject, however, to existing easements for public roads and highways, public utilities, railroads and pipelines.
- 4. A plan showing the land taken is annexed hereto as Schedule "B" and made a part hereof.
