## RIGHT-OF-WAY PERMIT

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That the United States Department of Interior, Bureau of Land Management, Grantor, does hereby grant to the State of Washington, Department of Natural Resources, Grantee, a perpetual right-of-way permit, including, but not limited to the right and privilege to locate, construct, relocate, maintain, repair, and use a roadway over and across the following-described real property situated in the County of Skaminia, State of Washington, to wit:

A parcel of land lying in the Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (NWANNA) of Section 10, Township 2 North, Range 7 East, Willamette Meridian, Skaminia County, Washington; being all that portion of said property contained within a strip of land 60 feet in width, the exterior side lines of said strip of land being extended or shortened at angle points to intersect adjacent segments of said exterior side lines and, except where extended at angle points, being 30 feet on each side of the described centerline shown on attached map which is made a part hereof.

The rights and privileges herein granted are for the use as a roadway by the Grantee, its Licensees and Permittees, including the right of access for the people of the United States generally to lands owned, administered or controlled by the Grantee for all lawful and proper purposes subject to reasonable rules and regulations of the
