March 1, 1917 (39 Stat. 948, 33 U.S.C. 701), which authorize the acquisition of land for flood control projects; the Act of Congress approved August 30, 1935 (49 Stat. 1028), which act authorizes the construction of the Bonneville Dam (Oregon and Washington); the Act of Congress, approved August 20, 1937 (50 Stat. 731), which act authorized completion, maintenance and operation of the project and the Act of Congress approved August 28, 1974 (Public Law 93-393), which act appropriated funds for such purposes. 8

- (b) The public uses for which said land is taken are as follows: The said land is necessary to provide for the construction of a river improvement for the purposes of flood control, navigation and for other uses incident thereto. The said land has been selected by me for acquisition by the United States for use in connection with the construction and maintenance of the Second Powerhouse which must be provided at the Bonneville Dam, and for such other uses as may be authorized by Congress or by Executive Order.
- 2. A general description of the land being taken is set forth in Schedule "A", attached hereto and made a part hereof, and is a description of the same land described in the cumplaint in the above entitled cause.
- 3. The estate taken for said public uses is the fee simple title, subject, however, to existing easements for public roads and highways, public utilities, radiroads and pipelines.
- 4. A plan showing the land taken is annexed hereto as Schedule "B" and made a part hereof.

The sum estimated by me as just compensation for said 5. land, with all buildings and improvements thereon and all appurtenances thereto and including any and all interests hereby taken in said land, is set forth in Schedule "A" herein, which sum I cause to be deposited herewith in the registry of the said court for the use and benefit of the persons entitled thereto. I am of the opinion that the ultimate award for said land probably will be within any limits prescribed by law on the price to be paid therefor.
