

SCHEDULE "A"

AUTHORITY FOR THE TAKING:

The authority for the taking of the land is under and in accordance with the Act of Congress approved February 26, 1931 (46 Stat. 1421, 40 U.S.C. 258a), and acts supplementary thereto and amendatory thereof, and under the further authority of the Acts of Congress approved April 24, 1888 (25 Stat. 94, 33 U.S.C. 591), and March 1, 1917 (39 Stat. 948, 33 U.S.C. 701), which authorize the acquisition of land for flood control projects; the Act of Congress approved August 30, 1935 (49 Stat. 1028), which act authorizes the construction of the Bonneville Dam (Oregon and Washington); the Act of Congress, approved August 20, 1937 (50 Stat. 731), which act authorized completion, maintenance and operation of the project and the Act of Congress approved August 28, 1974 (Public Law 93-383), which act appropriated funds for such purpose.

PUBLIC USES:

The public uses for which said land is taken are as follows: The said land is necessary to provide for the construction of a river improvement for the purposes of flood control, navigation and for other uses incident thereto. The said land has been selected by the United States for use in connection with the construction and maintenance of the Second Powerhouse which must be provided at the Bonneville Dam, and for such other uses as may be authorized by Congress or by Executive Order.

SCHEDULE "B"

TRACT NO. 2717

A tract of land situated in Section 21, Township 2 North, Range 7 East of the Willamette Meridian, Skamania County, Washington, being more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the Northeast corner of said Section 21; thence South 1,033.11 feet; thence West 3,051.04 feet to a point on the Northerly right-of-way line of the Evergreen Highway (State Highway No. 14); thence Easterly along said highway right-of-way 241.30 feet to the point of beginning; thence North 14°02'00" West at a right angle to said highway 200.00 feet; thence South 75°58'00" West 108.00 feet; thence South 14°02'00" East 100.00 feet; thence North 75°58'00" East 8.00 feet; thence South 14°02'00" East 100.00 feet; thence North 75°58'00" East 100.00 feet to the point of beginning, said tract being designated as Lots 5, 6, 16 and 17 and the Easterly 8.00 feet of Lot 15 of Block 20 of the unrecorded plat of the Town of North Bonneville, Washington.

Also the Southerly 25.00 feet of a former street lying Northerly of and adjacent to the above described tract heretofore vacated by order of the Town Council of the Town of North Bonneville, Washington.

Also including one-half of the adjacent streets and alleys.

The tract of land herein described contains 0.61 of an acre, more or less.
