REAL ESTATE CONTRACT

THIS CONTRACT, made and entered into this February, 1976.

GLEN D. GORDON and SHIRLEY J. GORDON, husband and wife,

hereinafter called the "seller," and HAROLD E. WHITE and KATHLEEN M. WHITE, husband and wife,

The said monthly installments shall include interest at the rate of nine percent (9%) per annum computed upon the monthly balances of the unpaid nurshase price, and shall be applied first to interest monthly balances of the unpaid purchase price, and shall be applied first to interest then to principal.
