(\$ 10.00 Dollars, to us in hand paid, and in further consideration of the general public
welfare, do by these presents grant, convey and dedicate to SKAMANIA County,
State of Washington, for the use of the public as a county road and appurtenances the following de-
scribed real property in the County of SKAMANIA, State of Washington:

A right of way for the Skamania County Road known and designated as the Lacock-
Kelchner Road (County Road No. 30950) located in the Southeast one quarter of Section
16, Township 3 North, Range 10 East W.M. in Skamania County, Washington.

MORE PARTICULARLY: A strip of land along the East edge of Lot 2 of the Ed Grove
Short Plat on file in the Auditor's Official Short Plat record, Skamania County.
This strip of land being 40 feet in width at the South end and 26 feet in width at the
North end. Said strip of land, as indicated, being 565 feet more or less in length.
