## DEDICATION DEED

GRANTOR(S) Hegewald Timber Co., a subsidiary of Louisiana Pacific Corporation for and in consideration of the sum of Ten Dollars and other valuable considerations (\$10.00) Dollars, to us in hand paid, and in further consideration of the general public welfare, do by these presents grant, convey and dedicate to SKAMANIA County, State of Washington, for the use of the public as a county road and appurtenances the following described real property in the County of SKAMANIA, State of Washington:

A right of way for the reconstruction of Second Street Extension (County Road No. 20770) located in the Southeast One Quarter of Section 2, Township 2 North, Range 7 E.W.M., Skamania County, Washington more particularly described as follows:

All that portion of the following described right of way lying within that certain parcel of land as described in that Quit Claim Deed to Hegewald Lumber Company from the State of Washington dated September 26, 1956 and on record with the Washington State Highway Commission, Department of Highways at Olympia, Washington

A strip of land 50 feet in width lying 50 feet on the right of the following described centerline, being 0.13 acres more or less.

## CENTERLINE DESCRIPTION

Beginning at Engineers Station 0 + 00, said point being N 39° 44' 30" E 1231.37 feet from a Skamania County Brass Monument marking the intersection of the West Line of the D. Baughman Donation Land Claim No. 4, with the South line of Section 2, Township 2 North, Range 7 E.W.M. in Skamania County, Washington; thence N 36° 41' 45" W 68.96 feet to the P.C. of a 150 foot radius curve to the right; thence following said curve 172.27 feet to P.T. Station 2 + 41.23; thence N 29° 6' 23" E 342.51 feet to the N.C. of a 1200 foot radius curve to the left; thence following said curve 250.31 feet to P.T. Station 8 + 34.04; thence N 17° 9' 18" E 165.96 feet to Station 10 + 00, end of project, said point being N 25° 31' 24" E and 2128.72 feet distant from the above mentioned Skamania County Brass monument.
