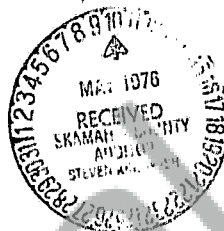

VANCAMP, deceased, one of the parties to said agreement, and it is intended that the statements set forth herein shall be considered representations of fact which may be relied upon by all persons dealing with the following described personal property, to-wit:

PERSONAL PROPERTY

FOURTH: That all obligations of the community owing at the date of death of decedent have been paid in full and all expenses of the last sickness have been paid.

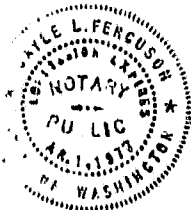
