The said monthly installments shall include interest at the rate of eight per-cent (8%) per annum computed upon the monthly balances of the unpaid purchase price, and shall be applied first to interest and then to principal. The purchasers reserve the right at any time they are not in default under the terms and conditions of this contract to pay without penalty any part or all of the unpaid purchase price, plus interest then due.

This contract shall not be assigned without the express written consent of the sellers and any purporred assignment thereof without such consent shall be null and void.
