The said land has been selected by me for acquisition by the United States for use in connection with the reregulation of the peaking discharge which must be provided at the Bonneville Dam, and for such other uses as may be authorized by Congress or by Executive Order.

2. A general description of the land being taken is set forth in Schedule "A" attached hereto and made a part hereof, and is a ~ description of the same land described in the complaint in the above entitled cause.
