## SCHEDULE "A"

THE RESIDENCE OF THE PROPERTY OF THE PROPERTY

AUTHORITY FOR TAKING:

In accordance with the Act of Congress approved February 26, 1931 (46 Stat. 1421, 40 U.S.C. 258a), and acts supplementary thereto and magnificant thereof, and under the further authority of the Acts of Congress approved April 24, 1888 (25 Stat. 94, 33 s.S.C. 591), and Marci 1, 1917 (39 Stat. 940, 33 U.S.C. 701), which authorize the acquisition of land for flood control projects; the Act of Congress approved August 30, 1935 (49 Stat. 1028), which are authorizes the conditruction of the Bonnaville Lock and Dam; the Act of Congress approved August 20, 1937 (50 Stat. 731), which are authorized completion, maintenance and operation of the project and the Act of Congress approved Becamber 26, 1975 (Public Law 94-180), which act appropriated funds for such purposes.

## PUBLIC USES:

The public uses for which said land is taken are as follows: The said land is necessary to provide for the construction of a raver improvement for the purposes of flood control, navigation and for other uses incident thereto. The said land has been selected by me for acquisition by the United States for use in connection with the construction and maintenance of the Second Powerhouse which must be provided at the Bonneville Dam, and for such other uses may be anthorized by Congress or by Executive Order.
