WITNESSETH: That the seller agrees to sell to the purchaser and the purchaser agrees to purchase from the seller the following described real estate, with the appurtenances, in Skamania County, State of Washington:

Lots 1 and 2 of SHON-TAY-RILL according to the official plat thereof on file and of record at page 159 of Book A of Plats, Records of Skamania County, WA: said real property being located in the southeast quarter of the northwest quarter (SEM NW M) of Section 32, Township 2 North, Range 5 E. W. M.

That after the approval by the State or Washington of the subdivision water supply system the purchasers shall have the right to connect to the subdivision's water supply upon the payment to the Sellers of an additional \$300.00 cash, payable at the time that the request for hook-up is made. That the purchaser agrees to abide by the rules, regulations and covenants for said water system as set forth in the restrictions and conditions contained in the dedication of Shon-Tay-Rill subdivision recorded February 13, 1968 under Auditor's File No. 69595, Book "A" at page 139.

been paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, and the balance of said purchase price shall te paid as follows: One Thousand Two Hundred and no/100 + interest (\$1,200,00 + int) Dollars, or more at purchaser's option, on or before the 15th April , 19 78, One Thousand Two Hundred and no/100 + interest (\$ 1,200.00 + int), Dollars, or more at purchaser's option, on or before the April 15th day of each succeeding calendar remain until the balance of said pur hase price shall have been fully paid. The purchaser further agrees to pay interest on the diminishing halface of said purchase price

15th nt the rate of 8% per cent per annum from the day of March which interest shall be deducted from each installment payment and the balance of each payment applied in reduction of principal, All payments to be made hereunder shall be made at 303 East 16th Street, Vancouver, Washington to: Donald E Eby or at such other place as the seller may threat in writing

As referred to in this contract, "date of closing" shall be upon completion of the contract

c. Any existing contract or contracts under which seller is purchasing and real relate, and any mortgage or other obligation, which seller by this contract upress to pay, none of which for the purpose of this paragraph (5) shall be deemed defects in seller's title.
