TEMPORARY SPOIL DISPOSAL PERMIT

WHEREAS, the City of North Bonneville, Washington, hereinafter called the "Owner", is the owner of real estate hereinafter described and whereas the Owner desires the Government to deposit spoil material on said described lands, thus raising the lands above the 100-year flood plain, hereby grants to the United States of America or its assigns, hereinafter called the "Government", a permit upon the following terms and conditions:

- 1. The Owner hereby grants to the Government an irrevocable right to enter upon the lands hereinafter described at any time from the date of this instrument until January 1, 1982, in order to deposit spoil from the Second Powerhouse Project and/or other dredged or excavated materials and further, the Owner does hereby covenant that he is the lawful owner of a sufficient estate in the said lands to enable him to give the permission herein granted and that the said lands are free from any encumbrances which would interfere with the said permission. If any deficiency of title exists which interferes with this permit, the city will promptly, at its expense, clear title to either surface or subsurface rights.
- ond-not-otherwise conveniently available to the Government, and a right of way for men, pipelines and machinery and or other equipmen over and acruse saidlands along such routes as may be necessary for the he sinabove stated purpose-
- 3. All tools, equipment, and other property taken upon or placed upon the land by the Government shall remain the property of the Government and may be removed by the Government at any time within a reasonable period after the expiration of this permit.
- The Owner hereby releases the Government from any claim or demand whatsoever for injuries suffered by or done to the said premises by reason of the deposit of spoil or other dredged or excavated material.
- The Owner must remove any existing structures on the premises within 30 days from the execution of this permit at the Owner's expanse. If not removed within this period, the Government will have the right to raze or destroy said structures without penalty or liability because of such action.
- The land affected by this permit is located in the State of Washington, County of Skamania, and is described as follows:
