IN THE MATTER OF SR 14 (PSH No. 8), Prindle to Skamania Pit and Stockpile Sites; Stockpile Site No. 4458; Surplus Land.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that THE STATE OF WASHINGTON, for and in consideration of TWENTY-EIGHT THOUSAND AND NO/100 (\$28,000.00) DOLLARS, hereby conveys and quitclaims unto THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, all its right, title and interest, in and to the following described

real property situated in Skamania County, State of Washington:

That portion of the S. M. Hamilton Donation Land Claim No. 40 in the northeast quarter of the southwest quarter and the northwest quarter of the southeast quarter of Section 20, Township 2 North, Range 7 East, W. M., lying southeasterly of the southeasterly right-of-way line of State Highway Route 14 (PSH No. 8), as said highway existed January 28, 1949, date of that deed to the State of Washington recorded March 17, 1949, in Volume 32 of Deeds, page 315, under Auditor's file No. 38984, records of said county, and lying northerly of the northerly right-of-way line of the Spokane, Portland and Seattle Railroad; subject to an existing road along the northeasterly end of the above described tract.

The specific details concerning all of which may be found on sheet 1 of that certain plan entitled SR 14 (PSH No. 8), Prindle to Skamania Pit and Stockpile Sites, now of record and on file in the Office of the Director of Highways at Olympia, Washington, bearing date of approval October 8, 1948, revised February 4, 1949.

The lands herein described are not required for State highway purposes and are conveyed pursuant to the provisions of RCW 47.12.080.
