IT IS FURTHER AGREED that the whole of the community property now owned by us or hereafter acquired by us, including all property the status of which is changed or created by this agreement, shall at once, in the event of the death of DAVID A. PAGE while the said MARTHA B. PAGE survives, be vested in MARTHA B. PAGE absolutely and in fee simple as her sole and separate property; and in the event of the death of the said MARTHA B. PAGE while the said DAVID A. PAGE survives, then the whole of the community property now owned by us or hereafter acquired by us, including all property the status of which is changed or created by this agreement, shall at once vest in the said DAVID A. PAGE absolutely and in fee simple as his sole and separate property.
