WHEREAS, by that certain Right of Way Contract dated December 14, 1955, recorded in the Records of Skamania County, Washington, in Book 41, page 104, Oliver I. Knoles and Clarissa M. Knoles, his wife, as Grantors, granted and conveyed unto Pacific Northwest Pipeline Corporation, a Delaware Corporation, its successors and assigns, a right of way and easement to construct, maintain and operate a pipe line or pipe lines on a right of way fifty (50) feet in width over and across the following described lands situated in Skamania County, Washington to wit:

The South Half (S1/2) of Section 9; the West Half of the Northwest Quarter, the North Half of the Southeast Quarter, the South Half of the Northwest Quarter and Government Lots 1, 8 and 9, in Section 16; all in Township 2 North, Range 7 E. W. M.; EXCEPT the strips of land acquired by the United States in 1920/76 by deed and by condemnation by the United States for Bonneville Power Administration's electric power lines and easements for access roads appurtenant thereto and except the following described interests therein:

1. That portion of Government Lots 8 and 9 of Section 16, Township 2 North, Range 7 E. W. M., more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point marking the intersection between the center of Greenleaf Creek and the south line of said Government Lot 9, said point being located on the north line of the B. B. Bishop D.L.C.; thence following the center of Greenleaf Creek in a northeasterly direction to a point in the said Government Lot 8 north 430 feet from the north line of the said Bishop D.L.C.; thence westerly parallel to, and 430 feet distant from, the north line of the said Bishop D.L.C. to intersection with the west line of the said Government Lot 9; thence south to the north line of said Bishop D.L.C.; thence easterly along the north line of said Bishop D.L.C. to the point of beginning; EXCEPT that portion thereof lying westerly of the natural gas pipeline constructed by Pacific Northwest Pipeline Corporation.

2. An easement granted to the Northwestern Electric Company, a Corporation, for an electric power transmission line.

WHEREAS, Northwest Pipeline Corporation, a Delaware Corporation, hereinafter referred to as Grantee, is the successor in interest to Pacific Northwest Pipeline Corporation, and;

WHEREAS, Elizabeth Bond Starker, a widow, the undersigned Grantor is now the owner of the above described property and;

WHEREAS, the Grantor and Grantee desire to, and have agreed to amend said Right of Way Contract,

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of Ten Dollars (\$10.00) and other consideration paid to the Grantor by the Grantee herein, the receipt

of which is hereby acknowledged, the Grantor and Grantee do hereby amend said Right of Way Contract to provide as follows:

(1) An additional right of way twenty-five (25) feet in width, parallel and adjacent to and northerly of the existing fifty (50) foot width of right of way referred to above, thus providing one continuous right of way seventy-five (75) feet in width being fifty (50) feet northerly of and twenty-five (25) feet southerly of Grantee's now existing pipeline across the above described land.

(2) During temporary periods, Grantee may use an additional width of 25 feet of the property along and adjacent to the said right of way as may be necessary in connection with the construction, maintenance, repair, removal, or replacement of the pipeline or pipelines.

(3) Grantor hereby reserves the right to cross said 75 foot right of way with roads, sewer lines, water lines and power lines provided crossings are in compliance with Grantee's reasonable specifications for such crossings. Grantor shall give Grantee 72 hours written notice of intent to construct a road or service facility crossing.

Said Right of Way Contract, as hereby amended, shall be binding upon the parties hereto, their heirs, successors and assigns. Except as hereby amended all terms and provisions of said Right of Way Contract are continued in full force and effect.


