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PACIFIC CREST TRAIL EASEMENT

THIS EASEMENT, dated this 33" day of August, 1977, from Harold W. Bialkowsky and Margaret M. Bialkowsky, hereinafter called "Grantor," to the United States of America, hereinafter called "Grantee,"

"ITNESSETH:

1,500.00 Grantor, for and in consideration of the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, does hereby grant and convey to Grantee and its assigns an easement for the Pacific Crest Trail, along and across a strip of land hereinafter defined as the "easement," over and across the following described real property:

SANWANWA, Section 23, T.4N., R.7L.

Said casement shall be 20 feet in width, being 10 feet in width ou each side of the centerline of the Pacific Crest Trail as it now exists or as now located and marked on the ground, with such additional widths as required for accommodation and protection of cuts and fills, said existing trail and marked location being approximately located and described as shown on Exhibit A which is attached hereto and made a part hereof. The trend width of the trail may vary within the right-of-way limits of said easement.

If the trail where not yet constructed is located substantially as described herein, the centerline of said trail as constructed is hereby deemed accepted by the Grantor and Grantes as the true centerline of the casement granted.

The acquiring agency is the Forest Service, Department of Agriculture.

Grantor and Grantee do hereby covenant and agree for themselves, their successors and assigns that they shall use and restrict the use of the easement as set forth below:

Use by Grantee

Grantee shall have the right to

Construct, reconstruct, improve, control, and maintain the Pacific Crest Trail within the easement area for use by Grantee and its assigns, including contractors, licensees, permittees, and ensement grantees.

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- (b) Reconstruct, operate, use and maintain any segment of said trail that may be destroyed through logging operations or otherwise.
- (c) Cut and clear timber and other vegetation in construction and development of the trail and related facilities.

2. Use by Grantor

- (a) No building, structure or improvement of any kind shall be constructed, crected or moved cuto the easement area.
- (b) No signs, billboards, outdoor advertising structures or advertising of any kind will be erected or displayed on the easement area.
- (c) No trash, ashes garbage, sewage, sawdust or any unsightly or offensive material shall be placed on the easement area.
- (d) Grantor's use of the trail on the easement for access to its lands shall be pursuant to the Regulations of the Secretary of Agriculture as provided for in the Act.

3. Reservations by Grantor

- a) Grantor reserves for itself, successors, and assigns:
 - (1) The right to grow and harvest timber crops on the easement area and to move logging equipment and skid logs across the trail and easement.
 - (2) The right to cross and recross the easement at any point ... I for any purpose in such manner as will not materially interfere with the use of the trail.

If for a period of five (5) years the Grantee shall cease to use, or preserve for prospective future use, the trail, or any segments thereof, or if at any time the Regional Forester determines that the trail, or any segment thereof, is no longer needed, the sasement traversed thereby shall terminate In the event of such nonuse or of such determination by the Regional Forester, the Regional Forester shall furnish to the Grantor a statement in recordable form evidencing termination.


