Estate, Office of the Chief of Engineers, dated 25 July 1977, recorded in Volume

County, Washington; for the relocation of the City of North Bonneville, Washington,
and in satisfaction of the obligations, of the Government imposed by Article 5 of
Relocation Contract No. DACW57-76-C-0039 dated 19 August 1975, for and in considera-

hereby conveys and quitclaims to Lawrence Edmond Burson, Jr.

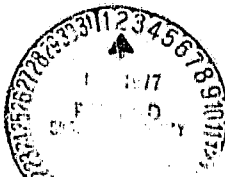
