parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of One Hundred and no/100 Dollars,

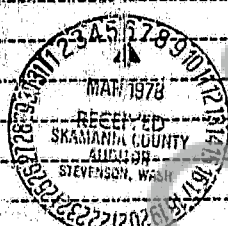
lawful money of the United States of America, to them in hand paid by DALE W. MIDLAND and TEDDI R. MIDLAND, husband and wife,
