The South 1,060 feet of the west 208 feet of the North-west Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section 15, Township 3 North, Range 10 E. W. M.; EXCEPT the south 644 feet thereof.

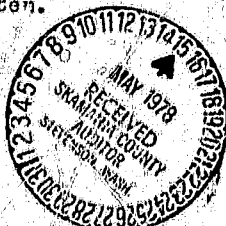

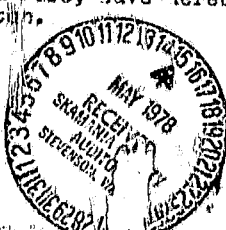
