## REAL ESTATE CONTRACT

## WITNESSETH:

That for and in consideration of the covenants and agreements hereinafter provided, the Seller hereby agrees to sell and convey to the Purchaser, and the Purchaser agrees to buy of the Seller the following described real property, hereinafter referred to as the "premises" or the "property", upon the terms and conditions provided to the this contract. in this contract.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPERTY: Situated in Skamania County, State of Wasnington:

Lot 3, Buhman Heights, according to the plat thereof, recorded in Book "B" of Flats, page 20, records of TOGETHER WITH a perpetual casement for ingress, egress TUGETHER WITH a perpetual casement for ingress, egress and utility purposes on and over Barbara Lane as delineated on said plat, and SUBJECT TO private roadway agreement now on file with Skamania County regarding the use and maintenance of said road. SUBJECT TO reservations and casements, including casements for file with the shown on the ment for fixe protestion purposes, as shown on the face of said plat.



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AND AS CONDITIONS HEREOF THE PARTIES COVENANT AND AGREE AS FOLIGWS:

1. CONSIDERATION AND PAYMENT: The total purchase and male price is the sum of NINE THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED AND NO/100 DOLLARS (\$9,500.00), of which Furchases has paid to Seller the sum of ONE THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED AND NO/100 DOLLARS (\$1,500.00) upon the execution

of this contract, the receipt whereof Seller hereby acknowledges. The balance of the purchase price in the amount of \$8,000.00 shall be due and payable in monthly installments of EIGHTY AND NO/100 DOLLARS (\$80.00), or more at Purchaser's option, commencing on September 1, 1978, and continuing on the first day of each month thereafter until the entire purchase price and interest is paid in full, or until eight (8) years after the execution of this contract, whichever shall first occur, PRO/IDED HOWEVER, that the total payment to the purchase price, exclusive of interest, shall not exceed \$2,850.00 during the calendar year 1978 except with Seller's prior written consent. The declining principal balances of the purchase price shall bear interest from July 1, 1978, at the rate of eight and one-half percent (8-1/2%) per annum, and the monthly installments aforesaid shall be first applied to the interest accruing from month to month and the balance credited to the principal.

- 2. TAXES AND ASSESSMENTS: Seller warrants that the real property taxes and all assessments against the property are paid through the calendar year 1977. Purchaser coverants to seasonably pay all such real property taxes and any other governmental or municipal assessments thereafter levied on the property during the performance of this contract.
- 3. INSPECTION AND MOK OF DOSS: Purchaser agrees that he has fully inspected the roat property serein bargained to be sold and is relying on no representations of warranties except as expressed in this contract. Purchaser assumes the risk of loss or damage to said property by fire or otherwise, and agrees that the destruction of said property, in whole of is party or that the taking of said property or any part thereof for public use, shall not constitute a failure of consideration on the part of the Seller.
- 4. POSSESSION, USE AND TITE: Purchaser shall be entitled to the possession of the propertupon the execution of this contract and thereafter while this contract is not in default, except that seller reserves the privilege of inspecting the property at all reasonable times concerning the perfermance of this contract. Purchaser covenants to use the premises in a lawful manner and to commit or suffer no waste of the same. Purchaser covenants furner to seasonably pay all charges to said premises for repairs, utilities, improvements or otherwise, to the end that no liens for the same may attach to the property. If Purchaser shall fail or neglect to make any such payments, shall fail or neglect to pay the taxes or assessments thereon, or shall neclect any charge which in the opinion of Seller may attach as a lien to the premises, then Seller may, at his election, make any such payments, and any sums so paid by Seller shall be repayable by Parchaser on demand, or seller may, at his election, add the amount thereof to the unpaid balance of this contract.

Upon the complete payment and performance of this contract Seller covenants to execute and deliver to Purchaser a warranty deed an statutory form conveying the property as herein described and otherwise free of liens or encumbrances as of the date of this contract. Seller shall not warrant against any such liens or encumbrances that may be incurred or suffered by Purchaser subsequent to the date of this contract.

5. PERFORMANCE AND DEFAULT: Time and exact performance in all things shall be of the essence of this contract. In event of default by Purchaser in the payment of the several sums herein provided,

## 6. ADDITIONAL COVENANTS:

- (a) Purchasur covenants to cut no merchantable timber on the property until the purchase price is one-half (1/2) paid, except with prior written expent of Seller.
- (b) Weller agrees to furnish to Purchaser as so as procurable a policy of little insurance in the amount of the purchaser price insuring Purchaser's interest in the property pursuant to this contract.
