ORDER APPROVING FINAL REPORT AND
DECREE OF DISTRIBUTION

7 This matter coming on regularly for hearing this 11th day of
8 December, 1978, and the executrix appearing personally and being repre-
9 sented by her attorney Donald Simpson, and evidence being submitted in
10 support of the Final Report and Petition for Distribution, the Court finds:

11 1. That this is the time and place set for hearing upon the final
12 report and petition for distribution filed herein by the executrix, that
13 notice of the time and place of this hearing was duly published and given
14 by mail as provided by law, and that proper proof of such publication and
15 mailing is on file herein.

16 2. That no objections to the report and petition have been served
17 or filed herein.

18 3. That Robert P. Ash, Sr., died at Vancouver, Washington, on
19 May 22, 1977, at the age of 61 years. He was a resident at 9609 N. W. 31st
20 Avenue, Vancouver, Washington. He left a surviving spouse and one child,
21 namely,

22 Jean R. Ash, 9609 N. W. 31st Avenue, Vancouver, Washington 98665, and

23 Robert P. Ash, Jr., 3413 Linkwood Lane, Clovis, New Mexico 88101.

24 Robert P. Ash, Sr., died testate, leaving a last will and testament dated
25 March 28, 1967, and admitted to probate herein by Order dated July 5, 1977.
26 The last will and testament named the surviving spouse, Jean R. Ash, sole
27 beneficiary of this estate and also named her to act as executrix without
28 bond. The Order of July 5, 1977 confirmed her appointment; and Letters
29 Testamentary were issued to Jean R. Ash on July 5, 1977. An Order of Solvency
30 was entered herein on November 30, 1977 granting to the executrix unrestricted
31 non-intervention powers.

32 4. That the executrix duly inventoried and valued the property of

24 The foregoing claims have been paid in full. One additional claim by South-
 25 went Washington Hospital in the amount of \$171.90 was filed late, but was paid
 26 by the executrix. Funeral and burial expenses in the amount of \$1,063.98
 27 have been paid in full.

28 6. That an inheritance tax return was made to the Department of Revenue
 29 of the State of Washington. Inheritance tax was fixed and determined in the
 30 amount of \$1,500.63 and has been paid in full. An inheritance tax release
 31 dated March 28, 1978 is on file herein.

32 7. That a United States Estate Tax Return was made to the Internal Revenue

Order and Decreed

1 Service. It was determined that no tax was due and payable in this estate.
2 An Acceptance of Estate Tax Return dated May 5, 1978 issued by the Internal
3 Revenue Service showing no tax due is on file herein.

4 8. That the executrix retained an attorney in connection with the
5 probate administration of this estate. A reasonable fee to be allowed and
6 approved for the attorney's services is the sum of \$3,500.00. This amount
7 was claimed and allowed as a deduction in the state and federal death tax
8 returns. The executrix waives a fee for her services.

9 9. That administration costs and expenses and other disbursements
10 incurred and to be incurred in closing are as follows:

20 10. That all assets of this estate were community property. The
21 executrix is the surviving spouse and the sole beneficiary of the estate.
22 She has made no detailed account of cash receipts and disbursements except
23 as noted above, and none is required.

24 11. That the decedent and this petitioner owned real property in
25 Hardee County, Florida, valued at \$26,000.00. An ancillary probate admin-
26 istration has been conducted in Florida with costs estimated at \$1,500.00,
27 which have been paid by the executrix from her own resources.

28 12. That pursuant to her non-intervention powers, the executrix has
29 distributed to Jean R. Ash all of the stock and securities inventoried in
this estate. These distributions should be confirmed and all of the balance
of the assets in the estate should be distributed to Jean R. Ash as the
surviving spouse and sole beneficiary under the last will and testament.
This estate is ready to be settled and closed.

30 Now, Therefore, it is hereby

31 ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED:

32 (1) That the final report of the executrix of the ABC's entitled

1 estate be and it is hereby settled and approved;

2 (2) That the inheritance tax due the State of Washington was fixed
3 in the amount of \$1,500.68 and has been paid; and that no federal estate tax
4 is due in this estate.

5 (3) That all debts of the estate and the funeral and burial costs
6 have been paid.

7 (4) That a fee in the amount of \$3,500.00 is hereby approved and
8 allowed for the attorney for the executrix.

9 (5) That the executrix be and she is hereby given credit for all
10 payments and expenditures set forth in her final report and in this order.

11 (6) That Robert P. Ash, Sr., died testate, and that the sole
12 beneficiary under his will is his surviving spouse, Jean R. Ash.

13 (7) That the entire net estate, as inventoried and as described
14 above, be and it is hereby confirmed and distributed to Jean R. Ash
15 pursuant to her community property ownership rights and to the last will
16 and testament of Robert P. Ash, Sr.

17 (8) That upon the filing of receipts for distribution and for the
18 costs and expenditures approved herein, the executrix Jean R. Ash shall be
19 discharged and this estate shall be closed.
