

## STATUTORY VARRANUY DEED

THE GRANTOR, FIRST INDEPENDENT BANK, Trustee for EUGENE F. LACKEY and F. PEARL LACKEY, husband and wife, for and in consideration of Ten Dollars and other good and valuable consideration in hand paid, conveys and warrants to JAMES R. JOHNSON and SUSAN B. JOHNSON, husband and wife, the following described real estate, situated in the County of Skamania, State of Washington:

ALL that portion of the Southeast quarter of the Southwest quarter (SE\(\frac{1}{2}\) SW\(\frac{1}{2}\)) of Section 31, Township 2 North, Range 6 E.W.M., lying Easterly of a certain creek known as Sasquaten Creek and Southerly c. an existing gravel road extending in an Easterly and Westerly direction through said subdivision;
