## STATUTORY WARRANTY DEED

THE GRANTOR, FIRST INDEPENDENT BANK, Trustee for EUGENE F. LACKKEY and F. PEARL LACKKEY, for and in consideration of Ten and No/100 Dollars (\$10.00), and other valuable consideration in hand paid, conveys and warrants to WILMAR A. ELLIOT and EDITH F. ELLIOT, husband and wife, the following described real estate, situated in the County of Skamania, State of Washington:

The East 640 feet of the West 1320 feet of the North half of the Northwest Quarter ( $\frac{1}{4} \text{ NW}_\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section 6, Township 1 North, Range 6 E. W. M.; EXCEPT the North 835 feet thereof; and

ALL that portion of the North half of the South half of the Northwest Quarter ( $\frac{1}{4} \text{ S}_\frac{1}{2} \text{ NW}_\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section 6, Township 1 North, Range 6 E. W. M., lying Westerly of, but not adjacent to, County Road No. 1009 designated as the Smith-Cripe Road, and lying Northerly and Westerly of the center line of the existing access road constructed by the Bonneville Power Administration; EXCEPT the West 880 feet thereof.

This deed is given in fulfillment of that certain Real Estate Contract between Dean Vogt and Lois Vogt, husband and wife, and William Proksel and Lucille Proksel, husband and wife, as Seller s, and Wilmar A. Elliot and Edith F. Elliot, husband and wife, as Purchaser, which was recorded on September 13, 1971 at the County Auditor's Office in Skamania County, in Book 63, of Deeds, at Page 287; excise tax paid under No. 876. Seller's interest in said contract was assigned to Eugene F. Lackkey and F. Pearl Lackkey, husband and wife, on September 28, 1972 and recorded by County Auditor of Skamania County on September 29, 1972 in Book 64, of Deeds, at Page 556. Thereafter, Eugene F. Lackkey and F. Pearl Lackkey transferred their interest to Grantor above-named by Seller's assignment of Contract, recorded in Skamania County, Washington on September 12, 1975, as Document No. 81430, in Book 70, of Deeds, at Page 45; excise tax receipt No. 3696.


