PARTIAL TERMINATION OF EASEMENT

There was reserved to the United States of America, acting through the Forest Service, United States Department of Agriculture, by patent to Weyerhaeuser Company, dated June 20, 1977, recorded July 19, 1977, in Volume 73, page 46, Auditor's File No. 84458, Skamania County, Washington, certain easements for road right-of-way purposes.

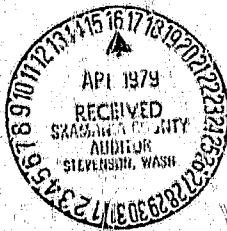
The United States does not now need nor foresee the need for certain of these easements under a portion of the land conveyed in said patent. Said easements which are no longer needed are described as follows:

## Road No. 928

Beginning at a point on the west section line of Sec. 6, which point is 1,280 feet, more or less, north of the southwest section corner of said Sec. 6, and traversing in an easterly direction over and across said Sec. 6, which point is 1,570 feet, more or less, north of the southeast section corner of said Sec. 6. Reentering said Sec. 6 at a point on the east section line of said Sec. 6, which point is 600 feet, more or less, north of the east  $\frac{1}{2}$  section corner of said Sec. 6, and traversing in a northwesterly direction over and across said Sec. 6 to a point on the north section line of said Sec. 6, which point is 1,160 feet, more or less, west of the northwest section corner of said Sec. 6, T. 9 N., R. 5 E., Willamette Meridian.

## Road No. N928

Beginning at a point on the west section line of Sec. 32, which point is 1,410 feet, more or less, north of the southwest section corner of said Sec. 32, and traversing in a northeasterly direction over and across the said Sec. 32 to a point which is 2,420 feet, more or less, north and 60 feet, more or less, east of the south  $\frac{1}{4}$  section corner of said Sec. 32, T. 10 N., R. 5 E., Willamette Meridian.



Therefore, I Robert M. Borman, for  
R. E. Worthington, Regional Forester, United States Department of  
Agriculture, do hereby certify that the easements above described  
are hereby terminated by the United States of America. The  
remainder of the easements reserved under the aforementioned patent  
remain in full force and effect and this partial termination has no  
effect thereupon.
