

Agreement as to Status of Community Property

After Death of One of the Spouses

Know All Men by These Presents:

That this agreement, made and entered into this 25 day of May, 1929,

by and between George H. Goldsmith

and Aladeen C. Goldsmith, husband and wife,

of Stevenson, Skamania County, State of Washington, WITNESSETH:

That, in consideration of the love and affection that each of said parties has for the other, and in consideration of the mutual benefits to be derived by the parties hereto, it is hereby agreed, covenanted, and provided:

That all property of whatsoever nature or description whether real, personal or mixed and wherever situated now owned or hereafter acquired by them or either of them shall be considered and is hereby declared to be community property.

That upon the death of either of the abovesigned parties title to all community property as herein defined shall immediately vest in the survivor of them.
