SUBJECT TO a life estate in the Grantors.

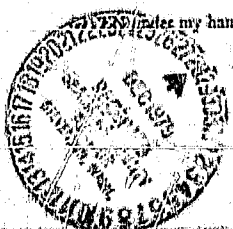
