REAL ESTATE CONTRACT

THIS CONTRACT FOR THE SALE OF LAND, made and entered into this 27th day of FEBRUARY, 1980, by and between BARBARA J. SPRINGER, as her separate property, hereinafter designated as "Seller" and PAUL VELTEN McWILLAN and NANCI LEE McMILLAN, husband and wife, hereinafter designated as "Purchaser",

WITNESSETH:

The Seller agrees to sell to the Purchaser and the Purchaser agrees to purchase of the Seller, the real estate hereinafter described.

 DESCRIPTION OF REAL ESTATE: The land herein conveyed is situate in the County of Skamania, State of Washington, to-wit:

Lot 14 of WHISPERING HILLS RIVER ESTATES, according to the official plat thereof on file and of record at page 130 of Book "A" of Plats, records of Stamania County, Washington.

2. PRICE AND PAT dENT: The purchase price of the sold real property is the sum of \$15,500,00,00 to shich the sum of \$3,500,00 has been paid, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, leaving a calance of \$12,000,00 to be paid in the following manner:

Payme its in the amount of \$110.00 per month, commanding the 20th day of March, 1980, and continuing on the 20th day of each month thereafter until this contract is paid in full.

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3. DEED AND TITLE INSURANCE—The title to the real property ferein described shall remain in the Seller until the purchase price together with interest thereon has been paid in full. Upon full payment of the purchase price and interest as herein provided, the Seller shall execute a Statutory Warranty Deed, conveying the premises heretofore described to Purchaser, free and clear of any liens and encumbrances except as set forth in this contract; provided that Seller shall not warrant against any encumbrances or liens placed against said premises by Purchaser, or suffered or permitted by and through Purchaser.

Seller agrees that within fifteen days from date hereof, he will provide the purchaser with a property title insurance policy showing marketable title of record in the Furchesse, subject only to the contract right of the other, so policy to out what is known as a "Purchaser's Policy".

- 1. FILLMENT DEED: When Purchaser has paid the balance of the restract down to the sum of \$5.090.00. Seller will great Purchaser a deed in fulfillment of this contract; provided interest is current and Seller is given assertly on other real estate acceptable to Seller. The remaining balance of \$5,000.00 shall be secured by a promissory note and mortgage bearing the same payment terms as this contract.
- 5. <u>PAXES</u>: The Purchaser assumes and agrees to pay before delinquency all texes and assessments that may herein become a lien upon said premises and property. The taxes for this year have been adjusted between the parties.
- 6. ASSUMPTION OF RISK : Purchaser assumes all risk of damage to any improvements upon the premises, or of the taking of any part of the property for public use; and no such damage or taking shall constitute a failure of consideration, but in case of such damage or taking, all noneys received by the Seller by reason thereof shall be applied as a payment on the purchase price of the property, less any sums of money which the Seller may be required to expend in procuring such money, or at the election of the Seller, to rebuilding or restoration of such improvements.
- 7. WASTE: Purchasor agrees to take good and proper onre of the premises, and not to permit, suffer or allow strip or waste of the same.

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- 8. <u>INSPECTION</u>: It is understood that the Purchaser has made a full inspection of the real estate and that no promist, agreement or representation respecting the condition of any building or improvement thereon, or relating to the alteration or repair thereof, or the placing of additional improvements thereon, shall be binding unless the promise, agreement, or representation be in writing and made a part of this contract.
- 9. ASSIGNMENT DF CONTRACT: This contract shall not be assigned, or the property sold or rented, without the written consent of the Seller being first obtained. Any assignment hereof shall not relieve the assignor from his obligation hereunder.
- 10. <u>POSSESSION</u>: The Furchaser shall have the right to the possession of said property seven days after closing; provided, however, that the Purchaser shall, upon default hereunder, and upon demand of the Seller, surrender to the Seller, peaceable possession of said premises.
- II. <u>DEFAULT CONDITIONS</u>: Time and exact performance are of the essence of this contract and in the event of the failure of the Purchaser to make any payment or keep any covenant herein provided for, this contract may be forfeited and terminated at the option of the Seller, and Seller may re-enter and repossess the premises, retaining all of the purchase price paid and all improvements placed upon the premises as compensation for the use of the premises and as liquidated damages for the breach of this contract.

In the event of forfeiture, Seller shall give a thirty-day notice of its intent to declare a forfeiture in writing to Purchaser. Within this thirty-day period, the Furchaser shall have the right to remove the grounds for forfeiture. Purchaser shall be reinstated only upon Purchaser paying to the Seller all reasonable and necessary expenses that Seller has incurred in the service of such notice, including a reasonable altorney's fee. No waiver by the Seller of any default on the gart of the Purchaser shall be construed as a waiver of any subjequent default.

12. <u>NOTICE CONDITIONS</u>: 11 in agreed that service of all demands or notices with repeat the this non-silve are take make by catilled

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mail with return receipt requested, directed to the Seller or the Purchases at their last known address. The time specified in any notice shall commence to run from the date of the postmark. Failure to pick up certified mail shall not be dremed lack of notice.

- 13. <u>LATE CHARGES</u>: If payments due hereunder are more than ten days late, a late charge of \$15.00 shall be charged for each such payment. In addition to late charges, if any payment is more than thirty days delirquent, the entire unpaid balance of the contract shall bear interest at twelve percent per annum until all payments delinquent are brought current.
- 14. RICHTS UPON ADVANCEMENT: If Purchaser fails to make any payments to others as herein provided, Seller may make such payments and any amounts so paid by the Seller together with interest a rate of twelve payment (12%) per annum thereon from date of payment

repaid, shall be repayable by Purchases on Seller's domain. All without prejudice to day other rights the Seller might have by reason of such left out; and further, Seller may if he so elects, add any amounts part by Schoon Purchaser's behalf to the contract balance, such sum or sums to be no others of t velve percent (12 to per annum until paid.

5. LEGAL ACTION: In the event suit or action is brought to terminate this contract or to enforce any of the provisions hereof, the prevailing party shall be antialed to recover all costs, including title research costs, and expenses incurred in connection with said action in addition to such sum for attorney's fees as to the Court may seem just and equitable.
