PASEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT, made and entered into this pl day of February ,1980 by and between BROUGHTON LUMBER CO., a Washington Corporation, herein called "Broughton", and S.D.S. CO., a partnership, herein called "S.D.S.", WITNESSETH:

A. Broughton for and in consideration of the grant hereinafter made by S.D.S. hereby grants and conveys to S.D.S., its successors and assigns, a permanent easement unon, over, and along rights of way thirty (30) feet in width, over and across the SE SES SES; and the NE SES SECTION 1, Township 3N, Range 9E, W.M.; the NE NOTH South centerline Section 12, Township 3N, Range 9E, W.M.; the NW SW SECTION 13, and NE SECTION 14, all in Township 3N, hange 9E, W.M.; and the W NW SECTION 7, Township SN, Range 10E, W.M., in Skamania County, Washington, being fifteen (15) feet on each side of the centerline of a road or roads located approximately as known in red on the attached "Exhibit A".

B. S.D.S., for and in consideration of the grant hereinabove made. hereby grants and conveys to Broughton, its successors and assigns, termanent easement upon, over, and along rights of way thirty (30) feet in width over and across the SERNER Section 12, Township 3N, Range JE, W.M., and the NWRSWR Section 6, Township 3N, Range 10h, W.M., in Ekamania County, Washington being fifteen (15) feet on each side of the centerline of a read or roads located approximately as shown in Green on the attached "Exhibit A".

The parties hereto hereby agree that the rights hereirabove granted by one part; hereto to the other shall be subject to the followin; terms and conditions:

1. The easements are conveyed for the purpose of construction, econstruction, use and maintenance of a road or roads for the purpose of hauling to. products and other valuable interials from lands now owned or hereaft r acquired by the parties hereto, and to provide access to said lands for land mann enough and administrative activilies.

Provides, however, thirty (if) days prior to any reconstruction, and/or betterment of said rest by either party on lands of the other party, the initiating party will submit to the laudowning party a written request for joint review of the proposed project, upon completion or shigh the initiating party will submit a complete and detailed plan of operations. Each party's operations, specified herein shell be conducted in accordance with the provisions of the approved plan of operations. Saic parties shell provide the other party the right of examination of the right of way before a., construction, reconstruction, or development is commenced.

- 2. Each party hereto reserves for Itself, its successors and assigns, the right at all times for any purpose, to cross and recross at any place on grade or otherwise on its own lands, and to use said rights of way in a reanner that will not unreasonably interfere with the rights granted herein.
- 3. Each party hereto may grant to third parties, upon each terms as it chooses, on its own lands, any or all of the rights reserved by it herein; provided, that use by such party shall be subject to the terms and conditions of this agreement and shall not unreasonably interfere with the rights granted to the other party herein.
- 4. Each party hereto may permit its respective agents, contractors, licensees, lessees, ourchosers of timber or other valuable materials, and their agents, hereinafter individually referred to as "Permittee" and collectively referred to as "Fermittees," to exercise the rights granted to it herein; provided, that when a party hereto or one of its Permittees plans to use any portion of said roads for the purpose of hauling timber or other valuable materials, such party shall notify the other thereof at least fifr en (15) days prior to the commencement of use of said rights, advising of the portion of road to be used, the approximate dates when such use will begin and end, and of the appreximate volumes of forest products or valuable materials to be hauled and forthwith upon the completion of such use notify the other party thereof.

- The cost of road paintenance and resurfacing shall be allocated on the basis of respective uses of said roads. When any party uses a road, that party shall perform or cause to be performed, or contribute or cause to be contributed, that share of maintenance and resurfacing occasioned by such use as hereinafter provided. During periods when a road is being used solely by one party, such party shall maintain that portion of said road so used to the standards existing at the time use is commenced. During periods when more than one party is using the same road, or any portion thereof, the parties hereto shall meet and establish necessary maintenance provisions. Such provisions shall include, but shall not be limited to:
- (a) The appointment of a maintainer, which may be one of the parties hereto or any third party, who will perform or cause to be performed at a reasonable and agreed upon rate the maintenance and resurfacing of the road
- or the portion thereof being used; and

 (b) A method of payment by which each party using said road or
 a portion thereof, shall pay its pro rate share of the Lost incurred by said
 maintainer in maintaining or resurfacing said road or portion thereof.

 For purposes of this agreement, maintenance is defined as the bork

normally necessary to preserve and keep the roadway, road structure and road facilities as nearly as possible in their present condition or as hereafter

- U. Each party using any portion of a road shall repair, or cluse to be repaired, at its sole cost and expense, that damage to said road occasioned by it which is in excess of that which is would cause through normal and prudent usage of said road. Should inordinate damage to a road occur which is not caused by an authorized user of said road, the parties hereto shall neet to agree upon the cost of replacement, the party to undertake the replacement, and the shares of replacement cost to be borne by each user of said road.
- 7. Unless the parties hereto agree in writing to share the costs of improvements in advance of such improvements being made, such improvements shall be solely for the account of the improver.
- 8. Each party hereto reserves to itself all timber now on or hereafter growing within the rights of way on its said lands.


