THIS MATTER, having come on regularly for hearing before
the undersigned Judge of the above-entitled Court as an uncontested
action for dissolution of marriage; the petitioner appearing in
person to give testimony, and by and through her attorney, Gerald L.
Wear, the respondent not appearing but having previously consented
to the entry of this Decree of Dissolution through his counsel's
signature hereon; the court having heard the testimony presented,
and having considered the files and records herein, having entered
its Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, in writing, and more
than ninety days having elapsed since the service of process and
the filing of the Petition herein, now, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED:

1. That the bonds of matrimony now and heretofore existing
between BETTY L. HAMMERICH, Petitioner, and RICHARD R. HAMMERICH,
Respondent, and the same are hereby set aside and canceled and the
marriage of the parties is hereby dissolved.

2. That the petitioner shall be, and hereby is, awarded
the care, custody and control of the minor child of the parties,
Cathy Jo Hammerich, born May 11, 1972, subject to respondent's
reasonable rights of visitation. That respondent shall be required

1 to pay support and maintenance in the amount of \$200.00 per month,
 2 commencing March 10, 1980, and such payments shall continue in
 3 said sum on the same day of each month thereafter, payments to be
 4 made payable to petitioner through the Clerk of Superior Court,
 5 Clark County Courthouse, P. O. Box 5000, Vancouver, Washington 98663,
 6 and further, that respondent shall also provide such group medical,
 7 dental and hospital insurance as is available for such child through
 8 respondent's employment or union membership. Such support provisions
 9 shall continue until the minor child attains the age of majority
 10 or completes high school in her normal class progression, whichever
 11 last occurs, until the child becomes otherwise self-supporting prior
 12 to the age of majority, or until the further order of the court.
 13 Further, that respondent shall be entitled to claim the minor child

2 of petitioner and/or her minor children.

3 4. That respondent shall be, and hereby is, awarded as
4 his sole and separate property all personal property and effects now
5 in his possession, including the 1974 Chevrolet pickup truck, the
6 U.S. bonds now in respondent's possession, any funds or deposits now
7 in respondent's possession or control, any and all interest in the
8 Crown Zellerbach retirement plan and Federal Social Security benefits
9 which have accrued by virtue of respondent's employment.

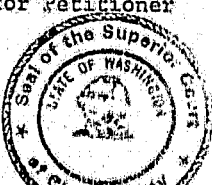
