WITNESSETH, that said party of the first part, has remised, released and quitclaimed, and by these presents does remise, release and quitclaim unto the said party of the second part and its assigns forever, all the right, title, interest, claim and demand which the party of the first part has in and to the land described as follows:

The westerly 20 feet of the following described tract of land:

That portion of the Samuel and Mary Jane Hamilton D.L.G., designated as Claim No. 40 in Sections 19 and 20, Township 2 North, Range 7 E., W.M., lying northerly of the right-of-way acquired by the Spokane, Portland & Seattle Railway Company, southerly of the right-of-way acquired by the State of Washington for Primary State Highway No. 8, and westerly of Hamilton Creek.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same together with all and singular the appurtenances, hereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining, and all the estate right, title or equity, to the only proper use, benefit and interest of the said party of the second part, its assigns, forever.

This deed is given pursuant to and as partial performance of Relocation Contract No. DACW57-76-C-0147 between the parties hereto. No monetary consideration is being paid for this deed, the consideration being other lands to be conveyed.

This deed has been re-executed and is being re-recorded for the reason that the legal description set forth is the original deed recorded on October 29, 1980 in Book of Deeds 38, page 914 in Skagit County, Washington is incomplete.
