EASEMENT

S.D.S., for and in consideration of a similar grant to be made by the State, hereby grants and conveys to the State, its successors and assigns, a permanent casement upon, over, and along rights of way thirty (30) feet in width for existing road as shown in red, and sixty (60) feet in width for new construction as shown in yellow on attached Exhibit A, over and across the SELNEL, Section 12, Township 3 Worth, Range 9 East, W.H., Skamania County, Washington.

Subject as to said lands to all matters of public record.

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The parties hereto hereby agree that the rights hereinabove granted shall be subject to the following terms and conditions:

- 1. The easement is conveyed for the purpose of construction, reconstruction, use and maintenance of a read or roads for the purpose of hauling forest products and other valuable materials from lands now owned or hereafter acquired by the State, and to provide access to said lands for land management and administrative activities.
- 2. S.D.S. reserves for itself, its successors and assigns, the right at all times for any purpose, to cross and recross at any place on grade or otherwise, and to use said rights or way in a manner that will not unreasonably interfere with the rights granted to the State herein.
- 3. S.D.S. may grant to third parties, upon such terms as it chooses, any or all of the rights reserved by it herein; provided, that use by such party shall be subject to the terms and conditions of this agreement and shall not unreasonably interfere with the rights granted to the State herein.
- 4. The cost of road maintenance and resurfacing shall be allocated on the basis of respective uses of said roads. When any party uses a road, that party shall perform or cause to be performed, or contribute or cause to be contributed, that share of maintenance and resurfacing occasioned by such use as hereinafter provided. During periods when a road is being used solely by one party, such party shall maintain that portion of said road so used to the standards existing at the time use is commenced. During periods when more than one party is using the same road, or any portion thereof, the parties hereto shall meet and establish necessary maintenance provisions. Such provisions shall include, but shall not be limited to:
 - (a) the appointment of a maintainer, which may be one of the parties hereto or any third party, who will perform or cause to be performed at a reasonable and agreed upon rate the maintenance and resurfacing of the road or the portion thereof being used; and

or the portion thereof being used; and
(b) a method of payment by which each party using said road or a
portion thereof, shall pay its pro rata share of the cost incurred by
said maintainer in maintaining or resurfacing said road or portion
thereof.

For purposes of this agreement, maintenance is defined as the work normally necessary to preserve and keep the roadway, road structure and road facilities as nearly as possible in their present condition or as hereafter improved.

- 5. Each party using any portion of a road shall repair, or cause to be repaired, at its sole cost and expense, that damage to said road occasioned by it which is in excess of that which it would cause through normal and prudent usage of said road. Should installate damage to a road occur which is not caused by an authorized user of said road, the parties herety shall must to agree upon the cost of replacement, the party to undertake the replacement, and the shares of replacement cost to be borne by each user of said road.
- 6. Unless the parties hereto agree in writing to share the cost of improvements in advance of such improvements being made, such improvements shall be solely for the account of the improver.

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- 7. S.D.S. reserves to Atself all timber now on or hereafter growing within the rights of way on its said lands.
- 8. The State may permit its respective agents, contractors, Licensees, lessees, purchasers of timber or other valuable materials, and their agents, hereinafter individually referred to as "Permittee" and collectively referred to as "Permittees," to exercise the rights granted to it herein: provided, that when the State on one of its Permittees plans to use any portion of said roads for the purpose of hauling timber or other valuable materials, such party shall notify S.D.S. at least fifteen (15) days prior to the commencement of use of said rights, advising of the pertion of road to be used, the approximate dates when such use will begin and end, and of the approximate volumes of forest products or valuable materials to be hauled and forthwith upon the completion of such use notify S.D.S.
- 9. The State shall require each of its Permittees, before using any of said roads for commercial purposes to:
- (a) obtain and during the term of such use, maintain a policy of liability insurance in a form generally acceptable in the trade and customary in the area of said rights of way, insuring said Permittee against liability exists out of its operations, including use of vehicles. Minimum amounts of insurance shall be:
 - (1) For log laulers, and other miscellaneous users operating heavy trucks (over one (1) ton), Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$250,000.00) for injury to one person, Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00) for any one occurrence, and Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$250,000.00) property damage for any one occurrence;
 - (2) For fern cutters, bough cutters, shake cutters, or other miscellaneous users operating pickup trucks, light trucks, (under one (1) ton) or passenger cars for the purpose of transporting miscellaneous forest products, One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00) for injury to one person, Three Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$300,000.00) for any one occurrence, and One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00) property damage for any one occurrence; or

(3) Such other limits as the parties hereto may agree upon in writing from time to time.

(h) deliver to S.D . a pertificate from the insurer of said Permittee certifying that coverage in not less than the above named amounts is in force and that, in the event of cancellation or modification of such coverage, the insurer will give S.D.S. ten (10) days' written notice prior to any cancellation or modifications.


