CENTERLINE DESCRIPTION

Beginning at Engineers P.I. Station 50+00.43, said station being on the east line of the SW 1/4, SW 1/4, NW 1/4 of said Section 21 and also being N 60° 51' 35" E 752.54 ft. from the Skamania County brass cap marking the quarter corner between Section 20 and 21, Township 3 North, Range 8 East W.M.; thence N 89° 43' 26" W 249.00 ft. to P.C. Station 52+49.43, being the P.C. of a 573 foot radius curve to the left; thence following said curve through a central angle of 27° 57' 06", 279.54 feet; thence S 62° 19' 27" W 22.84 feet to P.C. Station 55+51.81, being the P.C. of a 500 ft. radius curve to the right; thence following said curve through a central angle of 14° 20' 20", 125.13 ft. to P.O.C. Station 56+76.94. Said P.O.C. being at the intersection of the centerline with the west line of Section 21, Township 3 North, Range 8 E.W.M. The P.O.C. lying N 0° 31' 28" E 247.78 ft. from the quarter corner between Section 20 & 21, Township 3 North, Range 8 E.W.M.

RIGHTS-OF-WAY DESCRIPTION

A right-of-way 30 ft. in width lying southerly of, parallel, and contiguous to the above described centerline from P.I. Station 50+00.43 to P.O.C. Station 56+76.94.

Less existing rights-of-way for a net additional 0.15 acres more or less.

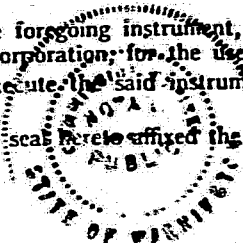
