## 1. History of Corner Establishment and Subsequent Restoration; description of Evidence Found:

I found two Bearing Trees as follows:

- 1) A 40-inch diameter Fir stump (6 feet high) South 78° East 15.15 feet with an overgrown face and cruiser marks. Old Washington State Division of Forestry tag nailed to the stump.
- 2) A 48-inch Fir stump (6 feet high) bears North 50° West 21.45 feet. Old scar has been chopped into.

Both of these trees probably have remnants of scribing, but I did not chop them out for fear of destroying the fragile faces.



## 2. Describe Monument, Accessories and Corollary Data to Perpetuate this Corner Location. Diagram corner and indicate meridian and reference to map of record.

 12" Fir North 28° East 13.89 feet.
