Name: One-quarter corner common to Sections 16 and 21. Corner No. _____
DLC, HES Mining Claim, Indian Allotment, Federal Reserve, Townsite

1. History of Corner Establishment and Subsequent Restoration; description of Evidence Found:

I found no evidence of the 8" Maple and the 10" Fir called for in the 1875 GLO notes. We calculated this corner by single proportion. This appears to be what has been used for this corner in the past. The single proportionate position for the South one-quarter of Section 16 lines up with the existing center of Section 21 and the South one-quarter corner of Section 21. This existing brass cap at the center of Section 21 may be the same corner as the stone monument shown on the 1916 plat of State Road No. 8. However, the distance North to the South one-quarter of Section 16 is shown as 2,661.6 feet vs. the present distance of 2,654.00 feet.

2. Describe Monument, Accessories and Corollary Data to Perpetuate this Corner Location. Diagram corner and indicate meridian and reference to map of record.

LAWSON LAND SURVEYING Job # 30-81-160310; Date of Work: May, 1981

Set a 1" galvanized iron pipe with brass cap and referenced it as follows:

- 50" diameter Fir bears North 12° East 44.15 feet.
- 50" diameter Fir bears South 31° West 30.79 feet.

This corner falls in the ditch on the West edge of the County Road.
