4 Bearing Tree stump pattern:

- 1 - 20" Fir B.T. stump at S73 30'E., 20.46 feet from corner location.
- 1 - 30" Fir B.T. stump at N 55 30'E., 21.12 feet from corner location.
- 1-28" Fir B.T. stump at N.10 W., 13.86 feet from corner location.
- 1-30" Hemlock B.T. stump at S.32 W., 23.76 feet from corner location.

No markings were found on any of above stumps.

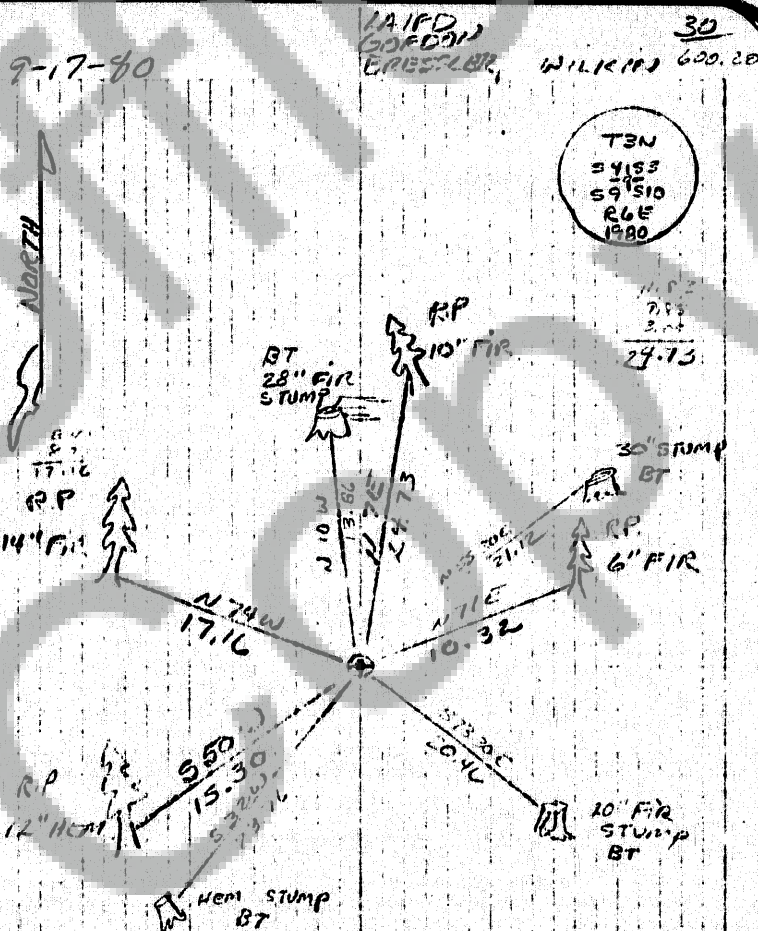
