### 1. History of Corner Establishment and Subsequent Resteration:

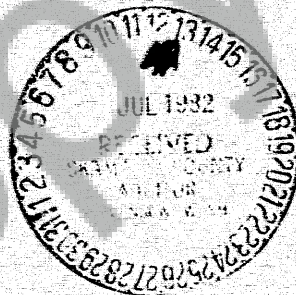
This corner was originally set by Deputy Lewis D.W. Shelton in July 1899, & Oct.-Dec. 1900 under Contract No. 552. Set Fir post. Remonumented by Floyd A. Brooks, Cadastral Surveyor in Oct. & Nov. 1961. Set Iron post with Brass cap. Scribed 14" Fir S65/2-E-6 lks.. Scribed 10" Hemlock N28 1/2 E-34 lks.. 8" Dogwood N47 1/2 W-18 lks.. 8" Hemlock S9W-32 lks..

### 2. Description of Evidence Found:

BLM 2 1/2" Iron post with 3" Brass cap.  
 Orig. 14" now 2 1/2" D-Fir uprooted open blaze S65 1/2 E-6 lks..  
 Brooks 10" now 14" Hemlock blaze grown over N28 1/2 E-34 lks..

New Bearing Tree:  
 12" Hemlock S64E, 18.3 ft. scribed N527 upper blaze and a lower blaze scribed BT and with a 3/4" Brass disk stamped PLS 1637.  
 Nailed 5/4-4 and BT signs to BT's.  
 Painted red band and blazes red.  
 Set guard post with sign 5/4-4 and BLM 102 decal East.
