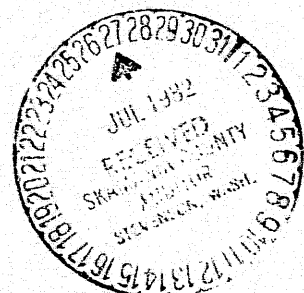
NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Wayne Epperson of Cowlitz county,

terms and conditions, to wit;

The said B/N and My Son's Logging, Inc., agreed to pay the  
said Wayne Epperson for such labor and assistance \$10,103.94: that  
said contract has been faithfully performed and fully complied  
with on the part of said Wayne Epperson, who performed labor  
upon and assisted in hauling said logs for the period of two months;  
that said labor and assistance were so performed and rendered upon  
said logs between the 3rd day of June, 1982 and the 23rd day of  
July, 1982 and thirty days have not elapsed since that time; that  
the amount of claimant's demand for said service is \$10,103.94;  
that no part thereof has been paid except \$1,895.96; and there is  
now due and remaining unpaid thereon, after deducting all just  
credits and offsets, the sum of \$8,207.94 in which he claims a

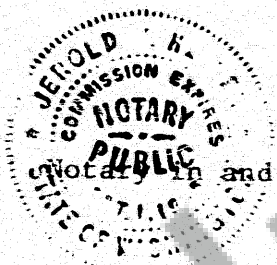
