assistance upon the following terms and conditions, to wit;

The said B/N and My Son's Logging, Inc., agreed to pay
the said William Jenks for such labor and assistance \$2,883.93;
that said contract has been faithfully performed and fully
complied with on the part of said William Jenks, who performed
labor upon and assisted in hauling said logs for the period
