TONY LUCHAU, CLAIMANT, VS BURLINGTON NORTHERN RAILROAD AND MY SONS'S LOGGING INC.

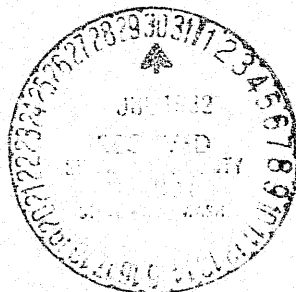

for labor performed upon and assistance rendered in hauling said logs; that the name of the owner or reputed owner is Burlington Northern Railroad (B/N) whose agent is My Son's Logging, Inc., that B/N and My Son's Logging, Inc., employed said Tony Luchau to perform such labor and render such assistance upon the following terms and conditions, to wit:

The said B/N and My Son's Logging, Inc., agreed to pay the said Tony Luchau for such labor and assistance \$13,678.30 that said contract has been faithfully performed and fully complied with on the part of said Tony Luchau, who performed labor upon and assisted in hauling said logs for the period of 11 weeks, that said labor and assistance were so performed and rendered upon said logs between the 3rd d , of May, 1982, and the 19th day of July, 1982; and the rendition of said service was closed on the 19th day of July, 1982, and thirty days have not elapsed since that time; that the amount of
