The said B/N and My Sons Logging, Inc., agreed to pay the said William W. Joner for such labor and assistance \$665.00; that said contract has been faithfully performed and fully complied with on the part of said William W. Joner, who performed labor upon and assisted in hauling said logs for the period of 9 days; that said labor and assistance were so performed and rendered upon said logs between the 28th day of June, 1982, and the 6th day of July, 1982; and the rendition of said service was closed on the 6th day of July, 1982, and thirty days have not elapsed since that time that the amount of
