
for labor performed upon and assistance rendered in hauling

The said B/N and My Son's Logging, Inc., agreed to pay the
said Roy McCall for such labor and assistance \$10,697.07; that said
contract has been faithfully performed and fully complied with on
the part of said Roy McCall, who performed labor upon and assisted
in hauling said logs for the period of two months; that said labor
and assistance were so performed and rendered upon said logs between
the 4th day of June, 1982, and the 16th day of July, 1982; and the
rendition of said service was closed on the 16th day of July, 1982,
and thirty days have not elapsed since that time; that the amount

of claimant's demand for said service is \$10,697.07; that no part thereof has been paid; and there is now due and remaining unpaid thereon, after deducting all just credits and offsets, the sum of \$10,697.07 in which he claims a lien upon all said logs. The said Roy McCall also claims a lien on all said logs owned by said B/N and My Son's Logging, Inc., of said county to secure payment for the work and labor performed in obtaining or securing the said logs, spars, piles or other timber, lumber or shingles herein described.

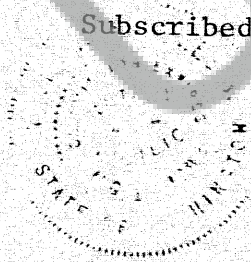



Log Cutters, Inc. to perform such labor and render such assistance upon the following terms and conditions, to wit:

The said B/N and My Son's Logging, Inc., agreed to pay the said S. & L. Log Cutters, Inc. for such labor and assistance \$26,516.25; that said contract has been faithfully performed and fully complied with on the part of said S. & L. Log Cutters, Inc., who performed labor upon and assisted in felling and bucking said logs for the period of three and one-half months; that said labor and assistance were so performed and rendered upon said logs between the 16th day of April, 1982 and the 28th day of July, 1982 and thirty days have not elapsed since that time, that the amount of claimant's demand for said service is \$26,516.25, that no part thereof has been paid except \$6,500.00; and there is now due and remaining unpaid thereon, after deducting all just credits and offsets, the sum of \$20,016.25 in which S. & L. Cutters, Inc.
