RONALD KATZER, CLAIMANT, VS BURLINGTON NORTHERN RAILROAD  
AND MY SON'S LOGGING, INC.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Ronald Katzer of Cowlitz County, State of Washington, claims a lien upon logs which were cut or manufactured in Skamania County, State of Washington, are marked thus <sup>BN</sup> 26; or <sup>BN</sup> 28; and are now lying in the following places:

for labor performed upon and assistance rendered in providing gas, grease, oil, transmission fluid, batteries, and labor on logging trucks (welding, etc.) and equipment of said logs; that the name of the owner or reputed owner is Burlington Northern Railroad (B/N) whose agent is My Son's Logging, Inc., that B/N and My Son's Logging, Inc., employed said Ronald Katzer to perform such labor and render such assistance upon the following terms and conditions, to wit:

The said B/N and My Son's Logging, Inc., agreed to pay the said Ronald Katzer for such labor and assistance \$1,120.27; that said contract has been faithfully performed and fully complied with on the part of said Ronald Katzer, who performed labor upon and assisted in providing the necessary maintenance and operating supplies for hauling said logs for the period of one month; that said labor and assistance were so performed and rendered upon said logs between the 28th day of June, 1982, and the 23rd day of July, 1982; and the rendition of said service was closed on the 23rd day of July, 1982, and thirty days have not elapsed since that time; that the amount of claimant's demand for said service is \$1,120.27;
