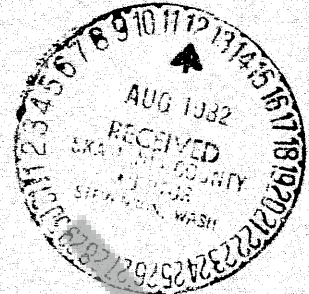

NOTICE OF CLAIM OF LIEN
FOR LABOR

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that TIMOTHY W. BARNWELL, of Clark County, Washington, claims a lien upon Douglas Fir and Hemlock logs, being about 696,000 board feet in quantity, which were cut in Section 8, Township 6 North, Range 6 East of the Willamette Meridian, in Skamania County, State of Washington, and are marked "EN 26", and are now lying in rafts situate principally in Cowlitz County, State of Washington, and are also situate in Pacific Lumber & Shipping Company's yard in Longview, Washington and in the Columbia River/Columbia River slough near Longview, Washington, in Rain Creek Log Sorting Company's Chelatchie yard and in Vanport Manufacturing Company, Inc.'s yard in Boring, Oregon, for labor performed in setting a choker and rigging a slinger in connection with services being performed and rendered to cut and remove the logs above described; that the name of the owners or reputed owners are EURLINGTON NORTHERN, INC., PACIFIC LUMBER & SHIPPING COMPANY, RAIN CREEK LOG SORTING COMPANY, and VANPORT MANUFACTURING COMPANY, INC.; that MY SON'S LOGGING, INC. employed said TIMOTHY W. BARNWELL to perform such labor and render such assistance upon the following terms and conditions, to-wit:

That said MY SON'S LOGGING, INC. agreed to pay the said TIMOTHY W. BARNWELL \$9.50 per hour for setting chokers and \$11.50 per hour for sling rigging, that said contract has been faithfully performed and fully complied with on the part of said TIMOTHY W. BARNWELL, who performed labor for a period including July 9, 1982 thru July 23, 1982,

that said labor and assistance was so performed and rendered upon said logs including the time between the 9th day of July and the 23rd day of July, 1982; and the rendering of said service was closed on the 23rd day of July, 1982, and 30 days have not elapsed since that time; that the amount of claimant's demand for said service is for 48 hours X \$9.50 per hour for setting chokers and for 24 hours X \$11.50 per hour for slinger rigging for a grand total of claimant's demand of SEVEN HUNDRED THIRTY-TWO and no/100ths (\$732.00) Dollars; that no part thereof has been paid and there is now due and remaining unpaid thereon, the sum of SEVEN HUNDRED THIRTY-TWO and no/100ths (\$732.00) Dollars Dollars less applicable Federal and State payroll deductions, for which amount he claims a lien upon said logs.
