NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that GEORGE M. CHEREPANOV, of Gervais, Oregon, claims a lien upon Douglas Fir and Hemlock logs, being about 696,000 board feet in quantity, which were cut in Section 28, Township 7 North, Range 6 East of the Willamette Meridian, in Skamania County, State of Washington, and are marked "BN 17", and are now lying in rafts situate principally in Cowlitz County, State of Washington, and are also situate in Pacific Lumber & Shipping Company's yard in Longview, Washington and in the Columbia River/Columbia River slough near Longview, Washington, in Rain Creek Log Sorting Company's Chelatchie yard and in Vanport Manufacturing Company, Inc.'s yard in Foring, Oregon, for labor performed in constructing fire trail and stream cleaning at the rate of 90 cents per foot, said fire trail and stream cleaning being performed and rendered to cut and remove the logs above described; that the name of the owners or reputed owners are BURLINGTON NORTHERN, INC., PACIFIC LUMBER & SHIPPING COMPANY, RAIN CREEK LOG SORTING COMPANY, and VANPORT MANUFACTURING COMPANY, INC.; that MY SON'S LOGGING, INC. employed said GEORGE M. CHEREPANOV to perform such labor and render such assistance upon the following terms and conditions, to-wit:

That said MY SON'S LOGGING, INC. agreed to pay the said GEORGE M. CHEREPANOV 90 cents per foot of fire trail; that said contract has been faithfully performed and fully complied with on the part of said GEORGE M. CHEREPANOV, who performed labor for a period including May 25, 1982

thru July 6, 1982, that said labor and assistance was so performed and rendered upon said logs including the time between the 25th day of May and the 6th day of July, 1982; and the rendering of said service was closed on the 6th day of July, 1982, and 30 days have not elapsed since that time; that the amount of claimant's demand for said service is Five Thousand Four Hundred Five and 04/100ths (\$5,405.40) Dollars; that no part thereof has been paid and there is now due and remaining unpaid thereon, the sum of Five Thousand Four Hundred Five and 04/100ths (\$5,405.40) Dollars less applicable Federal and State payroll deductions, for which amount he claims a lien upon said logs.

Claimant duly filed a Notice of Claim of Lien for Labor under date of August 3, 1982, wherein he described the logs as being marked "BN 26" instead of "BN 17". This Aended Notice of Claim of Lien for Labor is to be construed with said original Notice of Claim of Lien for Labor which was duly filed with the Skamania County Auditor on August 5, 1982, as prescribed by law, under Auditor's file No. 94518.
