1. History of Corner Establishment and Subsequent Restoration: Originally set by Justin Chenoweth during 1856 G.L.O. survey of TIN R4E. Restored July 1897 by Skamania County Surveyor, M. G. Lisher; no monument found in December 1979 when Hagedorn Inc. retraced Lisher notes and set a 2" iron pipe from 1 found B.T. stump. Corner shown on the following unrecorded 1971 Dept of Game survey. 1977 Wallace & Assoc. survey filed in Book 7 pg 106. 1979 Hagedorn Inc. survey filed in Book 11 pps. 8A-8B.

2. Description of Evidence Found:

Above mentioned 2" iron pipe and stamped brass cap.
Hole in ground at G.L.O. call of N 44 W, 96.4 ft.
(G.L.O. calls 50" fir at this location.)
Accepted corner.
